Dear Parents/Carers,

Over the last few weeks we have been getting ready for the reopening for the new school year. Although there may be some changes and some things will look very different the core purpose of the school remains the same. Our aim is to ensure our students grow into well rounded young adults, living as independently as possible and take the lead in living aspirational lives.

I'm sure that many of our pupils, especially new Year 7 pupils will have some anxiety about the new term. This is perfectly normal and all of the staff will be working with pupils to support them over the next few weeks and the rest of the year.
